**10 The rulers of the earth belong to God, and he is highly exalted.**

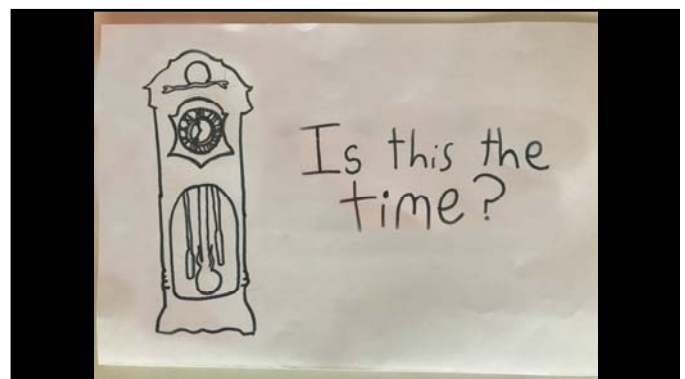
