

This is my Father's world O let me ne'er forget That though the wrong seems oft so strong God is the Ruler yet



Let us confess the faith of our baptism, as we say,


I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.



and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.






