READ Jeremiah 31:3,

As with hope, peace, and joy, love is something we both receive and participate in. Without us doing anything, God loves us. Jesus came as a human so he could help us understand this. Tuesday December 22- Light your love candle

REFLECTION

Light the love candle. Begin by closing your eyes and take 3 deep breaths, in through your nose and out through your mouth.

Recall words or phrases from the bible that talk about love. Jot them down on a piece of paper.

God is love

Love is of God. Anyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

Love is patient, love is kind...

The gift of love

The greatest of these is love

What do you notice? What do these tell us about the relationship between God and love?

Where there is love, God is present. What signals do you have that love is present?

Draw a heart and divide it up into 5 sections. Assign one word to each section: looks, feels, smells, sounds, tastes. Draw pictures or write words in each section that describe 'signals' that love is present in your experience.

For example, love tastes like my grandma's special bread

Love feels like...

Looks like...

Smells like...

Sounds like...

Tastes like...

Do any of your pictures have to do with someone who is in the room with you? If yes, let them know. How does it feel for them? If you wish, take a picture of your heart and post it on Padlet.

Bring to the mind the people in your life. Do you know of someone who is feeling lonely, sad or angry? Who comes to mind? How can you join the flow of love to this person? Could they use a call, a food drop off, a card, a gift or a text? Reach out in love to someone today, Christmas Eve.

What about your community? Is there a group, organization or cause you notice and want to support? How can you do that?

and/or

Is love prompting you to action for the greater good of the world? How can we join others to work for justice and restoration in the world? How can we put love into action in a new way?

As you finish, take 3 more deep breaths. Imagine breathing in the love of God, filling your whole body. As you breathe out, imagine love pouring out into the people in the room with you and into the world around you.

Wednesday December 23- Light your love candle

CREATE

Love – Create a card to send to students in a school in Pikangikum, an Ojibwe First Nation community

First, read about what's happening in the community, and look for it on a map!

Pikangikum Update...

The Church of the Resurrection community has been involved for the last two years in supporting the Pikangikum First Nations Community. We contributed money towards a project to help obtain a reliable water source to the community in 2018. In 2019, we participated in a drive for winter coats. Here is some updated information about what's going on in the community:

Fear of COVID is great in a remote community where access to medical resources is limited. There was one case in August that has been resolved. Students are all learning in their homes. This is challenging because some homes are not well equipped for families to be at home all day together. So, getting outside for exercise is important. The arena is open for pleasure skating. Elders are using this time to teach traditional food harvesting skills beyond the two-week fall goose and moose hunts. Once the ice is thick and safe, ice fishing is another activity.

There is still some money to help the people of Pikangikum secure a reliable water system. Unfortunately, this project has had some setbacks. One was a lack of electricity, then two forest fire evacuations and now, COVID-19 has continued to delay the project.
